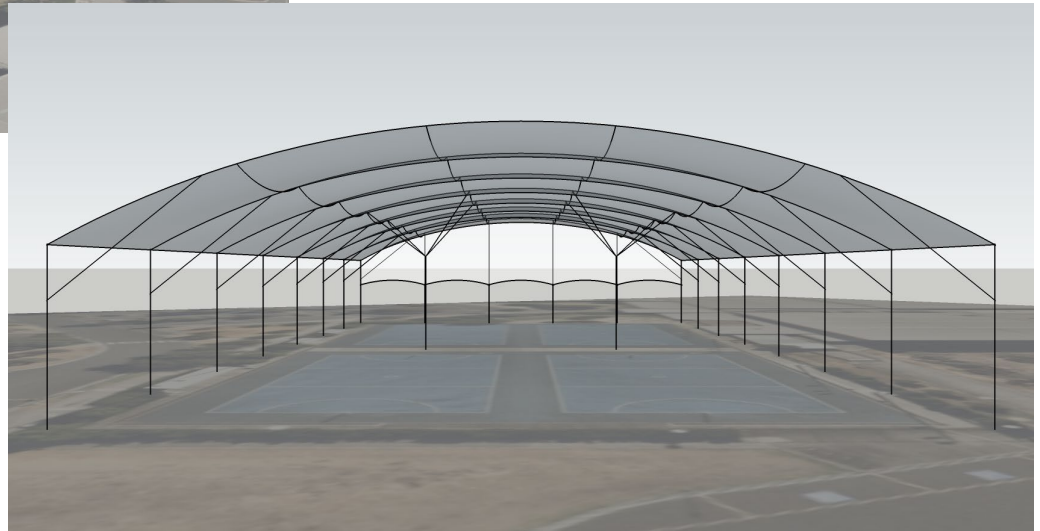
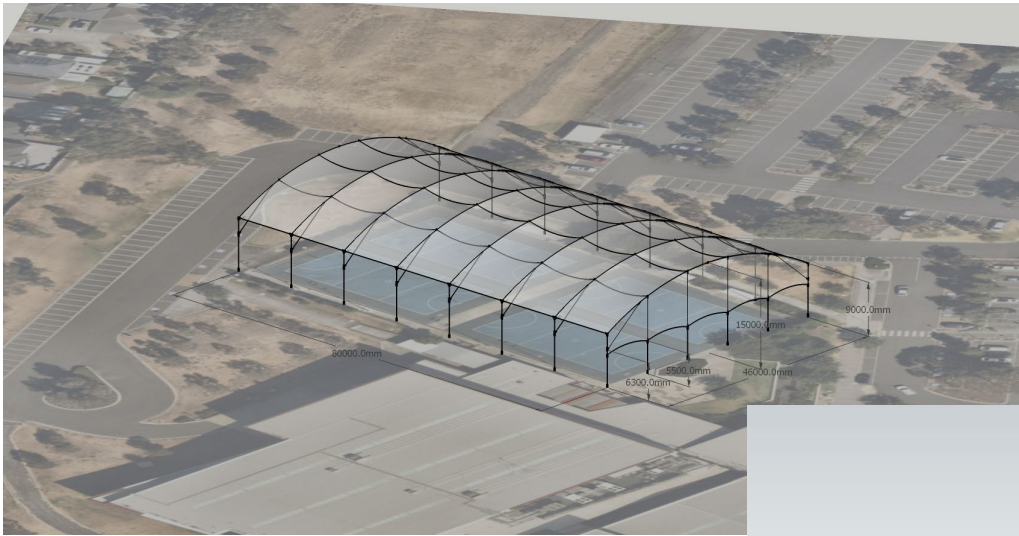

Year to Date Outlook

Budgeted for a small surplus.

Fee Structure Spring 2024

Fees as follows:

Team Registration	\$40, late @ \$60 (will be applied)
Under 9s:	\$55
Juniors:	\$60
Seniors:	\$70

Autumn Finals

- **Finals qualification = 40% of your teams fixtured games**
(Does not include byes)
- **40% qualification is rounded Down.**
E.g. 14 games = 5.6 = 5 games to qualify
- All Autumn 2024 Competition Finals will follow the 3 week format.

Spring Season

- Spring 2024 season starts: **Monday 15th July**
- Team registrations on Netball Connect or forms (Entity Teams) required by: **Sunday 23rd June.**
- **NC Open by Monday 10th June.**

GUIDELINES FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF SPORTS RELATED CONCUSSION IN NETBALL

NA PATHWAYS, YOUTH AND COMMUNITY NETBALL

5 APRIL 2024

- Applies to All Clubs/Teams.
- Any player who has suffered a concussion or a suspected concussion must not be allowed to return to play.
- A minimum of 21 days until resumption of contact/collision sport.

Items of General Business from the Board

- Concussion
- Concussion Recognition Tool 6 (CRT6) is recommended to help non healthcare practitioners recognise symptoms and signs of concussion.
 - Red Flag – No – refer to healthcare practitioner
 - Red Flag – Yes – immediate referral to emergency department
- HeadCheck app
- Graded Return to Play Framework.

General Business

Items of General Business from the Board

- Payment Plans
 - Trialled by Wyndham Victory in Autumn.
 - Significant reduction in committee effort chasing fees.
 - Positive response from families/players.
- Registration Module
 - Select Competition
 - Payments
 - Payment Plan – Manage Payment Plan
 - Add a new plan
 - Set minimum payment (at least VNA) and final date
 - Generates an email with a link to send to the member to activate the plan

General Business

Items of General Business from the Board

- Secondary Registrations – One-Off Fill-Ins
- 12 player limit on team listing

- A potential solution to requesting Secondary Registrations where the player is a one-off fill-in.
 - Noted on team list with “F”.
 - Written up on page 2. We create a new page 2.
 - No game stat.
 - No votes.
 - No finals qualification game, even if they do Secondary Registration in the future.
 - Must have VNA as usual.
 - Must follow new player/secondary registration if they play a subsequent game.
